Christian Zionism is a dangerous heresy that betrays true Christianity

THE TRUTH

Far from being heresy, Christian Zionism is a clear-eyed reading of both Scripture and history.

BACKGROUND

- On March 13, 2026, professional Israel critic Carrie Prejean Boller declared in an interview with Tucker Carlson that Christian Zionists are “heretics.” ([Tucker Carlson](#))
- The claim echoed one made by Tucker himself, who said in an October 2025 interview with neo-Nazi Nick Fuentes that Christian Zionism is “heresy.” He added that he “hates Christian Zionists more than anybody” and accused them of suffering from a “brain virus.” ([Tucker Carlson](#))
- Zionism is the belief that Jews have a right to their ancestral homeland.
- Christian Zionism adds that the restoration of Jewish sovereignty in Israel fulfills biblical prophecy.
- The return of the Jewish people to their land is the single most repeated promise in the entire Bible.

TRUTH EXPLAINED

- For more than 1,500 years, mainstream Christian theology – shaped by Augustine – taught that the Jews would remain in exile forever. This wasn’t just a religious belief; it was a prediction about history. The idea of a Jewish return to the Land of Israel was considered so impossible that Martin Luther famously joked that if the Jews ever got the land back, he would expect Christians to convert to Judaism too. - In 1948, centuries of Christian assumptions about Jewish exile were shattered. After nearly 2,000 years, Jews returned to their ancestral homeland, fulfilling the multiple prophecies that foretold their restoration. - Christian Zionists looked at that reality and updated their theology accordingly. That’s intellectual honesty, not heresy.
