

## No, Simping for Hamas Is Not America First

### THE LIE

You can be “America First” while obsessively attacking Israel, championing “Palestine,” and repeating Hamas talking points.

### THE TRUTH

Fixating on foreign conflicts and echoing the claims of foreign governments instead of your own is not “America First.”

### BACKGROUND

- Carrie Prejean Boller and Tucker Carlson present themselves as **“America First” conservatives devoted exclusively to American interests.**
- But instead of discussing **real issues affecting Americans**, they obsessively focus on condemning **Israel and supporting “Palestine” – two foreign entities.**

### TRUTH EXPLAINED

- On **Feb. 9, 2025**, Boller disrupted a hearing of the U.S. Religious Liberty Commission on antisemitism in America to **condemn Israel and defend “Palestine.”** She repeatedly **steered the discussion toward a supposed “genocide” in Gaza**, a foreign conflict unrelated to the topic of the hearing. - She appeared at the hearing **wearing a Palestinian flag pin rather than an American one.** ([X](#))
- During a **March 13, 2026 interview with Carlson**, Boller criticized Americans for supporting Israel because it is a foreign country—yet spent the entire episode attacking **Israel**, Americans who support **Israel**, and Christians who do not support **“Palestine.”** ([Tucker Carlson](#))
- Boller’s social media channels are **devoted entirely to attacking Israel, Zionism, and Americans who support them**—not real issues affecting everyday Americans. Likewise, much of Tucker’s platform and commentary centers on **Israel, Gaza, and the Palestinian cause.** ([Carrie Prejean Boller](#)), ([Tucker Carlson](#))
- Both Boller and Tucker **rely on claims from foreign governments** rather than their own. For example, they frequently repeat Hamas’ claim that **Israel is committing genocide** in Gaza, dismissing statements from **President Donald Trump, Vice President JD Vance**, and other officials who have explicitly said Israel is not committing genocide. - Boller and Tucker have also parroted Hamas’ claim that Israel killed **“70,000 innocent civilians,”** even though **President Trump has confirmed that most of those casualties were terrorists**, not innocent civilians. ([New York Post](#))

At a hearing about Americans, Boller shifted the focus to Gaza. On a national podcast, she repeated numbers supplied by Hamas. And while criticizing Americans for talking about foreign countries, she appeared wearing the flag of one. For someone presenting herself as "America First," her activism seems remarkably centered on **a foreign conflict, a foreign flag, and the claims of Gaza's government.**
